National Association of Church Design Builders To Host Seminar On Church Architecture and Construction Trends, April 24

Additional workshops scheduled throughout the year

ARLINGTON, Texas – National Association of Church Design Builders (NACDB) and Fort Worth-based design/build construction company G.L. Barron will host a seminar on church architecture and construction trends, April 24 at The Ballpark in Arlington.

The one-day workshop, “Architecture and Construction Trends For The 21st Century Church,” will provide a comprehensive look at newest trends, advances and innovations in church facility design and construction.

The main speaker for the seminar will be Greg Barron, president of both G.L. Barron and NACDB, an organization that provides religious and other non-profit groups with information on the planning, design and construction of churches and church-related facilities.
