“SWAPS 101-Know More than Your Banker” will be presented by Scott Rolfs, who manages the Church and School Financing Group at Ziegler. This workshop is designed to teach administrators, pastors and boards how to understand a SWAP and their mechanics as well as lenders.

“The Parable of Wal-Mart and One Light Bulb” will be presented by Bob Adams, a church development consultant for JH Batten, Inc. This workshop will cover three areas: helping churches understand what it means to be green, making sure the church is being managed properly and how to ensure the next facility built will be green as well.
